

# TROOP 20 SKI AND CAMP WEEKEND

On Friday 1/6/12 the Scouts of Troop 20 are getting together for our annual ski trip! We'll be leaving at 4:15 PM and driving to Camp Phillips – a Scout camp in central Wisconsin. We will overnight at the scout camp cabins we have rented, and than early Saturday morning, we will drive to the nearby Granite Peak Ski Resort which features a total of 72 ski runs! We will ski all day!!!!

The cost for this trip \$115.00. For Scouts that participated in the sale of Christmas Wreaths, a \$25.00 subsidy will be provided, thus bringing your cost to \$90.00.

This cost will cover camping fees, most meals, some snacks, ski lesson, equipment rental, lift tickets, helmet, and transportation. We will return on Sunday –mid afternoon.

Each Scout should bring about \$20.00- \$25.00 for spending money and dinner on the way up, snacks in the ski lodge, and lunch on the way home.

This site includes a great many runs, so as to cater to a variety of skill levels. Due to the nature of this trip, we need to have a fast turn-a-round on participation.
