Scouts should bring a sleeping bag and ground pad as we will be sleeping in the gym. As we have planned some pool time (as in swimming pool not billiards) Scouts should also bring a swim suit, (goggles if you use them), water shoes (optional) and a towel.

Scouts wishing to use the Climbing Wall must have the Great Lakes Waiver signed and returned as well (along with this Troop 20 permission slip). If you don't return a signed Great Lakes Waiver you cannot use the climbing wall - no exceptions will be made.

In the event of a medical emergency, I authorize Troop 20 Scoutmasters to render such aid or take actions necessary for his safety and well being. I further understand that in the event of emergency efforts will be made to contact me.

INDOOR CLIMBING WALL-WAIVER



NOTICE: THIS IS A LEGALLY BINDING CONTRACT. In consideration of my being permitted by Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) to climb on THE WALL, participate in one of THE WALL'S programs including orientation, I agree to the following waiver and release.

I HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE THE INHERENT EXTREME RISKS IN ROCK CLIMBING, including climbing on artificial surfaces. I realize that those risks include, but are not limited to: falls from or contact with walls and equipment, bad decision making, inattention of belayers or actions of other climbers, misuse or failure of equipment, holds which may come loose or damaged, and freakish accident which cannot be foreseen. I acknowledge that the above lists is not inclusive of all possible risks associated with the use of the facilities, and/or the sport of climbing and I agree that said list in no way limits the extent or reach of this release. I VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS WITH FULL KNOWLEDGE AND APPRECIATION OF THE DANGER AND RISK INVOLVED.

I voluntarily agree to assume all risk of personal injury, including paralysis and death, that may occur while I am in the facility, or participating in any event or program while I am climbing anywhere at any time, whether or not under supervision of MWR personnel. I hereby knowingly and intentionally waive and release and agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend MWR, it's successors, assigns, officers, employees, and wall designers and builders, hold manufactures lessors and agents from all liability for any such damage, injury paralysis or death which may result. This release shall be effective even though said loss, damage or injury results or has resulted from the negligence, wrongful acts, omissions, breach of warranty or strict tort liability of MWR or other parties released. _____ (initial)

I am in good health and have no physical limitations, which would affect my safe use of THE WALL. I agree to pay attention to the state of any ropes, anchors and other equipment I may use, and to advise staff members if I do any damage or notice damage. I certify that I have read the posted rules, and I agree to abide by these rules and any future rules, and if staff makes a specific request of or instruction to me I agree to comply. I understand that indoor climbing is not the same as outdoor climbing, which requires additional skills; and I agree to seek qualified instruction before attempting to climb outdoors. _____ (initial)

I am at least 18 years of age (or have a green Military I.D.) and otherwise legally competent to sign this agreement. This release shall be effective and binding upon me and upon my assigns, heirs, representatives, executors and administrators. If under the age of 18, this release must be signed by the parent/guardian of the minor, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless MWR and the other released parties in the event a minor member of my family sues them or any one of them. _____ (initial) (if not 18 please refer to the bottom of the page)
